The Conditions for Receiving a Plenary Indulgence:

It is necessary that the faithful be in the state of grace which means:

1. Have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin;
2. Have sacramentally confessed their sins;
3. Receive the Holy Eucharist;
4. Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis.

* The jubilee indulgence can only be applied to oneself or to the deceased.

** If legitimately unable to fulfill all the requirements above, one or more of the conditions for the plenary indulgence can be commuted by a confessor.
